
Fundraising and Donations

Two events were held to support our 2021 projects – essential repairs to the boiler room and the chancel windows. These were Plant Sale on 10th July, which raised £734.89 and a Quiz and Chips Night on 9th October, which raised £591.00. Our Annual Meeting and Garden Reception took place on 8th September and we were pleased to welcome many

of the Friends and their guests.

We received a number of very generous donations and collections during 2021, in particular from the funerals of Iris Colin and Betty Trendell, both longstanding Friends who will be greatly missed. As a result we were able to donate almost £7,000 towards the 2021 projects.
