Christ Church, Eaton: Lent Course 2026

Draw Near: Life-giving habits for Lent

How will you grow as a disciple this year?

Discipleship is more than intellectual agreement; it is committed "apprenticeship" to Christ. This Lent, we are invited to **Draw Near** by establishing rhythms that sustain our faith and shape our character.

Most of us desire to grow our spiritual life but struggle to find the "trellis" to support the vine and bear fruit. This course explores six core Christian habits—**Worship, Prayer, Scriptures, Communion, Service, and Sharing**—that provide the framework for a flourishing life in Christ. If you are interested in growing as a disciple, these sessions will offer practical help with theological depth.

The course is based on the official Church of England booklet, **Draw Near: Life-giving habits for Lent**, written by Kate Bruce, Michael Leyden, and Jessica Martin. It provides daily Bible readings and reflections to use at home and will inspire the Wednesday sessions.
